

# Homelessness in Pascoe Vale

There are **216 people** without a home in Pascoe Vale on any given night.

Homelessness affects **32 people per 10,000** compared to the state average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Pascoe Vale **54th out of 88** Victorian electorates.

## Tracking progress

In March 2023, the ABS released its Estimating Homelessness report from the 2021 Census, allowing us to compare how homelessness has changed since 2016.

**Since the last Census, homelessness has decreased by 22.4% in Pascoe Vale.**

In 2016, there were 278 people without a home, ranking Pascoe Vale 31st out of 88 Victorian electorates.
