Homelessness in Pascoe Vale

There are 216 people without a home in Pascoe Vale on any given night.

Homelessness affects 32 people per 10,000 compared to the state average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Pascoe Vale 54th out of 88 Victorian electorates.

Tracking progress

In March 2023, the ABS released its Estimating Homelessness report from the 2021 Census, allowing us to compare how homelessness has changed since 2016.

Since the last Census, homelessness has decreased by 22.4% in Pascoe Vale.

In 2016, there were 278 people without a home, ranking Pascoe Vale 31st out of 88 Victorian electorates.
