Homelessness in Ringwood

There are 374 people without a home in Ringwood on any given night.

Homelessness affects 47 people per 10,000 compared to the state average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Ringwood 31st out of 88 Victorian electorates.

Tracking progress

In March 2023, the ABS released its Estimating Homelessness report from the 2021 Census, allowing us to compare how homelessness has changed since 2016.

Since the last Census, homelessness has increased by 36.1% in Ringwood.

In 2016, there were 275 people without a home, ranking Ringwood 32nd out of 88 Victorian electorates.
