Homelessness in South Barwon

There are 849 people without a home in South Barwon on any given night.

Homelessness affects 117 people per 10,000 compared to the state average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking South Barwon 4th out of 88 Victorian electorates.

Tracking progress

In March 2023, the ABS released its Estimating Homelessness report from the 2021 Census, allowing us to compare how homelessness has changed since 2016.

Since the last Census, homelessness has increased by 472.1% in South Barwon.

In 2016, there were 148 people without a home, ranking South Barwon 66th out of 88 Victorian electorates.
