## Homelessness in Sunbury

There are 127 people without a home in Sunbury on any given night.

Homelessness affects 20 people per 10,000 compared to the state average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Sunbury 75th out of 88 Victorian electorates.

## **Tracking progress**

In March 2023, the ABS released its Estimating Homelessness report from the 2021 Census, allowing us to compare how homelessness has changed since 2016.

Since the last Census, homelessness has increased by 23.5% in Sunbury.

In 2016, there were 103 people without a home, ranking Sunbury 82nd out of 88 Victorian electorates.
