

# Homelessness in Sunbury

There are **127 people** without a home in Sunbury on any given night.

Homelessness affects **20 people per 10,000** compared to the state average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Sunbury **75th out of 88** Victorian electorates.

## Tracking progress

In March 2023, the ABS released its Estimating Homelessness report from the 2021 Census, allowing us to compare how homelessness has changed since 2016.

**Since the last Census, homelessness has increased by 23.5% in Sunbury.**

In 2016, there were 103 people without a home, ranking Sunbury 82nd out of 88 Victorian electorates.
