Homelessness in Warrandyte

There are 47 people without a home in Warrandyte on any given night.

Homelessness affects 6 people per 10,000 compared to the state average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Warrandyte 87th out of 88 Victorian electorates.

Tracking progress

In March 2023, the ABS released its Estimating Homelessness report from the 2021 Census, allowing us to compare how homelessness has changed since 2016.

Since the last Census, homelessness has decreased by 66.7% in Warrandyte.

In 2016, there were 141 people without a home, ranking Warrandyte 69th out of 88 Victorian electorates.
