Homelessness in Wendouree

There are 364 people without a home in Wendouree on any given night.

Homelessness affects 54 people per 10,000 compared to the state average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Wendouree 32nd out of 88 Victorian electorates.

Tracking progress

In March 2023, the ABS released its Estimating Homelessness report from the 2021 Census, allowing us to compare how homelessness has changed since 2016.

Since the last Census, homelessness has increased by 26.0% in Wendouree.

In 2016, there were 289 people without a home, ranking Wendouree 30th out of 88 Victorian electorates.
