## Homelessness in Williamstown

There are 177 people without a home in Williamstown on any given night.

Homelessness affects **27 people per 10,000** compared to the state average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Williamstown **64th out of 88** Victorian electorates.

## **Tracking progress**

In March 2023, the ABS released its Estimating Homelessness report from the 2021 Census, allowing us to compare how homelessness has changed since 2016.

Since the last Census, homelessness has decreased by 11.8% in Williamstown.

In 2016, there were 201 people without a home, ranking Williamstown 46th out of 88 Victorian electorates.
